





IRISHMEN AND IRISHWOMEN: In the name of God and of the dead generations from which she receives her old tradition of nationhood, Ireland, through us, summons her children to her flag and strikes for her freedom.

Having organised and trained her manhood through her secret revolutionary organisation, the Irish Republican Brotherhood, and through her open military organisations, the Irish Volunteers and the Irish Citizen Army, having patiently perfected her discipline, having resolutely waited for the right moment to reveal itself, she now seizes that moment, and, supported by her exiled children in America and by gallant allies in Europe, but relying in the first on her own strength, she strikes in full confidence of victory.

We declare the right of the people of Ireland to the ownership of Ireland, and to the unfettered control of Irish destinies, to be sovereign and indefeasible. The long us repation of that right by a foreign people and government has not extinguished the right, nor can a ever be extinguished except by the destruction of the Irish people in every generation the Irish people have asserted their right to national freedom and severeignty; six times during the past three hundred years they have asserted it in arms. Standing on that fundamental right and again asserting it in arms in the file of the world, we hereby proclaim the Irish Republic as a Sovereign independent State and we pledge our lives and the lives of our comrades-in-arms to the cause of its freedom. of its welfare, and of its exaltation among the nations.

The Irish Republic is entitled to, and hereby claims, the allegiance of every Irishman and Irishwoman. The Republic guarantees religious and civil liberty, equal rights and equal opportunities to all its citizens, and declares its resolve to pursue the happiness and prosperity of the whole nation and of all its parts, cherishing all the children of the nation equally, and oblivious of the differences carefully fostered by an alien government, which have divided a minority from the majority in the past.

Until our arms have brought the opportune moment for the establishment of a permanent National Government, representative of the whole people of Ireland and elected by the suffrages of all her men and women, the Provisional Government, hereby constituted, will administer the civil and military affairs of the Republic in trust for the people.

We place the cause of the Irish Republic under the protection of the Most High God, Whose blessing we invoke upon our arms, and we pray that no one who serves that cause will dishonour it by cowardice, inhumanity, or repipe In this supreme hour the Irish nation must, by its valour and discipline and by the readiness of its children to sacrifice themselves for the common good, prove itself worthy of the august destiny to which it is called.

This is a truly special year, as Irish people at home and abroad – that great extended Irish family around the world – mark the centenary of 1916.

Outside of Ireland, in no other country will the centenary have more resonance than in the United States. The testimony is there in the Proclamation itself. The text invokes the support of "our exiled children in America", and five of the seven signatories were significantly influenced by time they had spent in America. Throughout all the intervening years, the United States has continued to stand with us as a friend and partner.

As one of the foremost Irish cities in America, it is fitting that Chicago should host its own commemorations. In preparing the centenary programme, the Embassy and our Chicago Consulate are deeply grateful for the support and collaboration of partner organisations, such as Ireland Network Chicago.

A great deal of thought has been given to shaping the centenary programme. At home and abroad, our events will be built around themes of remembrance, reconciliation, imagination. As well as examining the 1916 legacy, we will chart the one hundred year journey, reflect on where we have arrived, and set our compass for the decades ahead.

Throughout the year, we will proudly showcase the dynamic, multi-faceted Ireland of today. This is the Ireland so well represented by contemporary organisations such as Ireland Network Chicago and its members – the Ireland that owes so much to the past but continues to focus resolutely on the future.

We are looking forward to an exciting and joyful year. We extend a warm invitation to all Irish people, Irish Americans and Ireland's friends across Chicago and the US Mid-West to join us and become part of this great global celebration and commemoration.




