

Message from Consul General Brian O'Brien,

22nd Consul General of Ireland to Chicago and the US Midwest

A Chairde, Dear Friends,

Since taking office as Consul General in December, I've had the privilege of attending a number of Ireland Network Chicago events and seeing first-hand the outstanding work you do to deepen connections between our global island and this great global city.

I arrived in Chicago at the end of what was a historic year for the Irish community here. Last May, the city was honoured by the appointment of Chicago resident Billy Lawless as Ireland's first Senator for the Diaspora. In August, Beverley born Maggie McEldowney was crowned the 57th Rose of Tralee, the first time a Chicago Rose to claim the award in three decades. And on 5th November, in front of a record-breaking crowd at Soldier Field, Ireland's senior men's rugby team defeated the All Blacks for the first time in 111 years of trying, a losing streak even the Cubs couldn't match.

IN-Chicago played a significant role in marking these historic achievements. And you were also at the heart of local commemorations of the Easter Rising of 1916, partnering with the Consulate, the Irish Fellowship, the Irish Georgian Society and others to host a major event at the Cultural Centre in June. Through events like this, and through the excellent *IN Conversation*, grant aided by our Government's Emigrant Support Programme, IN-Chicago continues to connect Irish and Irish-American professionals across this city. This matters hugely, because, whether political, in the arts or in business, the ties between Ireland and Chicago are ultimately developed, refreshed and sustained by people.

Nurturing these personal relationships, ensuring that Chicagoans' attachment to and understanding of Ireland is passed from one generation to the next, has been a priority of our Consulate since we opened our doors in 1933. It will remain so throughout my time as Consul General. Indeed, in the months and years ahead, as we seek to promote our nation's values and protect our people's interests, such communication will be more important than ever.

In this endeavour, our small team at the Consulate looks forward to further deepening our cooperation with IN-Chicago, under the stewardship of your new President, James Sheehan, and his Committee. We are grateful to you, and to all those who have devoted their time and effort to make this organisation what it is today. Maith sibh.



Greetings to the Ireland Network Chicago's Annual Ball, which I trust will be a great success. Unfortunately, I cannot be with you in person, as I am currently in Dublin. As you may know, I was recently appointed by An Taoiseach Enda Kenny TD to the Irish Senate to represent the Irish living overseas.

My appointment is an official and long overdue nod to Ireland's 70 million strong Diaspora and an acknowledgement that the people of our proud and ancient island desire a modern and mature relationship with their fellow Irishmen and women living abroad. It is also a testament to the hard work, leadership and dedication of many of you who seek to strengthen the ties between Ireland and the 40 million people in America who proudly claim Irish heritage.

I want each of you to know that I am committed to making your voice heard in An Seanad Éireann and in the highest chambers of government. If we as a nation are to live up to the virtues of the Proclamation of 1916 in 'cherishing all the children of the nation equally' then we must approach our Diaspora with respect and sincerity. And so, in my maiden speech to An Seanad Éireann, I respectfully challenged the chamber to ask itself "What can you do for your diaspora, rather than what can your diaspora do for you?"


I commit to working on issues that matter to you, such as the recent Seanad Reform Bill that includes a provision for voting rights for Irish citizens living abroad. I commend the Taoiseach for his willingness to engage on this matter but if 25 of the 28 countries in the EU can do it, then so can we.

Ireland is currently entering uncharted territory with the recent Brexit vote, which threatens peace at home and trade with our closest neighbour, not to mention the fate of 1 million Irish nationals living in Britain. Recent immigration executive orders and anti-immigrant rhetoric in the USA also present major challenges for the 50,000 Irish undocumented living in the shadows. I will not shy away from these difficult issues and will continue to advocate for all Irish citizens overseas, especially the most vulnerable.

I would like to thank the Ireland Network Chicago for its continued support of front line Irish service agencies and congratulate you on your great success.





IRELAND NETWORK CHICAGO PRESENTS 'OFF THE BALL'

2016 was a historic year for Irish Rugby and Chicago was the center of all the action. Last November, in an unexpected victory at Soldier Field, Ireland posted their first win in 29 matches spanning 111 years over the current rugby world champions, the New Zealand All Blacks. In doing so, they also ended the All Blacks' record run of 18 straight test wins.

The day before this historic victory, Ireland Network Chicago were proud to have hosted a key event that kicked off this rugby weekend. In collaboration with the Irish radio station, Newstalk, Ireland Network Chicago brought the award winning radio sports show, Off The Ball, to Chicago to host a daytime recording of their famous rugby roadshow. A dedicated audience battled their way to The Gage through a sea of Chicago Cubs fans on Michigan Avenue to hear a lively discussion with rugby and sporting stars hosted by Joe Molloy and Ger Gilroy from Newstalk.

The event was kicked off with some comedy from Aprés match's Risteard Cooper, who warmed up the crowd with some of his hilarious stand-up. This was followed by a panel of guests that included Brent Pope (RTÉ rugby analyst), Dan Payne (CEO of USA Rugby), Shane Ross (Irish Minister for Transport, Tourism and Sport), Tony Rice (Notre Dame Quarterback), Paul Manion (Dublin GAA team member) and Gerry Thornley (Irish times journalist). Our special guest, Keith Wood (Former Captain of Ireland and Munster), delighted fans with his insights on the upcoming match. Overall, the event was a huge success and the Ireland Network Chicago is proud to have participated in this memorable weekend.


















Valerie was born and raised in Dublin and has lived in Chicago since 1998. She graduated from






