WELCOME TO IRELAND NETWORK CHICAGO'S 2019 ANNUAL BALL



On this day sixteen years ago, we held our first Ireland Network Ball in this very hotel. At the time, we had grand aspirations for the potential impact of the Networks potential. Tonight's crowd is just one

of the many ways in which lofty aspirations have come to fruition. As a founding member of the Network all those years ago, it is wondrous to now lead the organization into a fresh 2019.

The past year has been rich with exciting events, including a boat cruise with former Taoiseach, Enda Kenny and the Lord Mayor of Dublin, as well as a lively tailgate for the Irish Rugby match with Italy.

Our programming continues in the up-coming months with an IN Conversation entitled, *Update from Leinster House* by Senator Billy Lawless and an IN Conversation with the celebrated film Director Jim Sheridan as we celebrate the Chicago Irish Film Festival's 20th Anniversary. I am pleased to share that the Irish Government continues to support our organization thanks to a generous grant from the Emigrant Support Program. We are extremely grateful for that continued support helping us grow and serve as a bright beacon for Irish People, wherever they were born or whatever Country or County they come from.

The Emigrant Support Program is a tangible expression of the Government's support, commitment, and interest in the global Irish community. Like no other nation in Europe it aims to strengthen the international Irish community and deepen its cherished bond with Ireland. Through this creative program, the Government intends to fund projects that promise a clear and identifiable impact on supporting and building global Irish communities. The Irish Abroad Unit in the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade manages and coordinates the program in partnership with Ireland's Embassies

and Consulates abroad. Since its inception in 2004, the Emigrant Support Program has assisted over 530 organizations in 36 countries with grants totaling over €170 million. Grants range from small amounts for grassroots groups, to major allocations awarded to large-scale volunteer and community organizations. In 2018 alone, there were over 490 applications from more than 20 countries, requesting over €21 million worth of funding for the Program's €11.6 million budget. We are proud of the steadfast support of the Irish Consulate here in Chicago over the years, and the leadership and energy of Consul General Brian O'Brien and Vice Consul Justin Dolan. Their patriotism and friendship is exemplary. With strong leadership comes new opportunities, and so we are saddened now to say goodbye to Justin, but delighted on his diplomatic advancement and promotion with a return to Ireland for his next chapter of service. Chicago will always hold a home for him anytime he wishes to return. May he have a future of promise. We know he will keep the Chicago flag flying wherever





Message from Consul General Brian O'Brien Consul General of Ireland to Chicago and the US Midwest

A Chairde, Dear Friends,

On behalf of the Government of Ireland, I want to thank the Ireland Network of Chicago for your outstanding work over the last year. You continue to reach out to newly-arrived Irish, you maintain strong ties with Irish people who have lived here for many years and you bring Irish, Irish Americans and Americans together. Your organisation embodies the Irish traditions of hospitality, friendliness and inclusiveness.

2018 has been a busy year for the Consulate. We have had a number of high level political visits from Ireland to the Midwest including for St Patrick's Day. 2018 was also the year that we helped facilitate Mayor Emanuel's first visit to Ireland where he was welcomed by the President, Taoiseach and Chicago's sister city of Galway. The visit was a chance to repay the hospitality shown by Chicago to Irish visitors over the years and underlined the strong links between Ireland and Chicago. The links remain strong because of organisations like yours and the power of our very active diaspora. Chicago is of course home to Ireland's only Senator for the Diaspora, Senator Billy Lawless.

Another highlight of 2018 was the Consulate's participation in the Chicago Pride Parade for the first time. There was much appreciation from the crowd for Ireland's message of equality and inclusion.

2018 was also a busy year for the Ireland Network with the Ball, the social events and the IN conversations series. I know that organising these event requires an incredible amount of work behind the scenes and I salute all of those who give their time, energy and creativity so generously.

I am delighted that the Irish Government, through the Emigrant Support Programme, continues to partner with the Ireland Network Chicago to help you continue to deliver your important programming.

Thank you also for your continued friendship and support. Our role in the Consulate is to tell the story of Ireland, to explain our culture and values and to make connections between Ireland and the Midwest. The work of Ireland Network greatly contributes to our goals and we deeply appreciate it.







A Cháirde.

Greetings to the Ireland Network Chicago's Annual Ball, which I know will be another successful highlight to Chicago's Irish social calendar. I trust it will be a great night for all. Unfortunately, I cannot attend in person, given that Seanad Eireann is in session but I wanted to thank you all for the stellar work that you do on behalf of Ireland.

The Ireland Network Chicago is one of the strongest and most vibrant chapters of INUSA and your annual ball is rightly looked to as the flagship Ireland Network event in the country. Your determination to connect young Irish professionals in Chicago to one another and to Ireland is an essential component to your success and to the very success of Ireland in America.

In an increasingly interconnected and volatile world your work in building strong business and networking relationships provides the foundation stones for Ireland to interact with the United States and the wider world. We at home appreciate your dedication to Ireland and acknowledge your contribution to ensuring that Ireland continues to punch above her weight at the international level.

We live in turbulent times where Ireland as a nation faces challenges not experienced since the foundation of the State. Brexit threatens not only the hard fought peace on our island but has the potential to upend years of economic growth and prosperity. We in government are working hard to ensure that Irish interests are protected and rights safeguarded, despite the UK's exit from the European Union. As always, we look to our friends in America in perilous times and thank you and your representatives in Congress who have stepped forward to support us in these important negotiations between the UK and the EU.

Congress has also recently been the focus of Irish concerns related to the E3 Work Visa that passed the House of Representatives but failed by one vote in the Senate. Along with other Irish immigration advocates in the United States, I was profoundly disappointed that the measure failed at the last post. The bipartisan, reciprocal agreement would have provided the annual 5000 unused Australian E-3 Visas to Ireland. We worked hard to ensure that American citizens wishing to retire in Ireland would also find it easier to do so, as part of Ireland's desire to be reciprocal. My disappointment is tempered only by the fact that we proved that much goodwill exists on the Hill towards Ireland and many opportunities lie ahead. I will endeavour to work closely with Irish immigration advocates In the USA in the coming year to advance a Work Visa Bill for Ireland and a resolution to the plight of the Irish undocumented living in the USA.

I want you to know that I am committed to making your voice heard in Seanad Éireann and in the highest chambers of government. If we as a nation are to live up to the virtues of the Proclamation of 1916 in 'cherishing all the children of the nation equally' then we must approach our Diaspora with respect and sincerity.

As such, I welcome the government's commitment to holding a referendum on Emigrant Voting Rights in the Autumn. I encourage you to get involved in the campaign to extend voting rights to Irish citizens in Irish presidential elections . If 25 out of the 28 countries in the EU can do it then so can we.

In closing, I would like to thank the Ireland Network Chicago again for its continued support of front line Irish service agencies and congratulate you on your great success this year.
