# WELCOME TO IRELAND NETWORK CHICAGO'S 2020 ANNUAL BALL

### Message from Consul General Brian O'Brien, Consul General of Ireland to Chicago and the US Midwest

A Chairde, Dear Friends,

Athbhliain faoi mhaise daoibh go léir. Happy New Year and New Decade to you all.

We are incredibly privileged in the Consulate to serve in a post with such a large and vibrant Irish diaspora. Some 8 million people across the Midwest claim Irish heritage, meaning this Consulate has one of the largest diaspora communities across our Diplomatic Network anchored in this great city.

Chicago is a global city at the centre of the US and enjoys a strong and longstanding relationship with Ireland, our global island. Chicago is also one of the most Irish cities on the globe. The strength and importance of Ireland's relationship with Chicago was evident last St Patrick's Day, as we had the great honour of hosting an Taoiseach, Leo Varadkar for the celebrations. For Diplomats such as myself and my colleague Vice Consul Sarah Keating, it doesn't get much bigger than hosting our head of Government for our national day!

Dear Friends, this is my fourth and final year as Consul General. As I reflect on my time here, my great lesson has been that as Diplomats, we do not have a monopoly on diplomacy or representing Ireland. We in the Consulate might have titles; host Taoisigh and visiting Ministers; meet with Governors, Mayors and political, community and business leaders. However, the work of organisations like the Ireland Network, reminds us that the strength of the relationship between Ireland and the US is — above all else - built on the strong people to people links. Ireland Network members are wonderful Ambassadors for Ireland.

I salute the work that you do to bring people together whether they are Irish, Irish American, have an affinity with Ireland, or are just curious about Ireland. I am delighted that the Irish Government, through the Emigrant Support Programme, continues to partner with the Ireland Network Chicago to help you in your endeavours.

To Ferdia Doherty, to the Executive committee, the Advisory board, thank you for all the incredible work that you do behind the scenes to make events, such as tonight happen, and indeed all the IN events such as Socials, IN Conversations, IN boat trips etc throughout the year. Organising such events requires an incredible amount of work behind the scenes and I salute all of those who give their time, energy and creativity so generously. It is heart-warming to see the strength and vibrancy of Ireland Network. Go raibh mile maith agaibh.

On a personal level, I want to thank you for your friendship and support to the Consulate and all in Team Ireland. Our job is to build and maintain bridges between our global island and this global city. IN Chicago makes that job a lot easier. I wish you every future success.

## Ireland Network In Spirit Award 2020

Each year, Ireland Network Chicago honors an individual who has made a significant and sustained contribution to the Irish community in Chicago with the IN Spirit Award. Ireland Network aims to convey our profound gratitude and appreciation and to bring attention to the incredible work done by fellow members of our community.



It is our great privilege to name **Dan O'Donnell** as this year's recipient of the IN Spirit Award. Dan's compassion and willingness to always help others is well known in our community. Through the incredible assistance he has provided to over 16,000 Irish students who have come to the United States on J-1 summer visas, Dan has developed and nurtured many positive connections and ties between Chicago and Ireland.

In 1996, Dan noticed a group of Irish students sitting on the curb for hours outside his Lincoln Park hardware store. Dan—of course—introduced himself. On learning that these students needed accommodation and summer employment, he immediately got to work. By the end of June 1996, he was arranging accommodation and employment, including at his store, for over 40 J-1 students. That number has since grown massively. Last year, Dan and his family had over 1,280 J-1 students come through their doors. Since 1996, Dan and his family have helped over 16,000 young Irish students make their dreams of an American summer a reality.

In addition to finding them accommodation and employment, Dan has truly strengthened the bonds between these many young Irish people and our great city by showing them around and entertaining them with boating on Lake Michigan, meals at local restaurants, and Cubs games. For these students, the summer in Chicago is, thanks to Dan, "the best summer ever." Dan's commitment to helping students goes even further—on many occasions, he has provided emergency accommodation and assisted in crisis situations. Dan's great work has been featured in a television program produced by RTÉ.

Dan's kindness, compassion, and dedication to helping others has truly enriched the lives of many. We are privileged to count him as a fellow member of our community and to present him with the IN Spirit Award.



#### A Cháirde,

I am sorry that I cannot be with you in person tonight but I wanted to wish you all a wonderful evening at the annual Ireland Network Chicago Ball. The Chicago chapter of the INUSA is a wonderful example for other networks to emulate. You have one of the most active and successful networks in the USA and you should be very proud as you celebrate tonight.

You bring together Irish professionals to network and continue to promote Ireland in all that you do from the centre of the American heartland. I have been privileged to take part in your speaker series and know first hand that you strive to educate your community and keep the INC connected to the most relevant issues facing Chicago.

In an ever changing world you build the foundation for Ireland's strong relationship with the USA as you foster business relationships on the ground. The Irish government appreciates your support and acknowledges your contribution at home.

It is, however, bitter sweet as I write to you. As you all know, the Irish government has called for elections on February 8th and unfortunately my tenure as a Taoiseach's nominee for the Seanad will come to an end with this current government. I have been honoured to represent the global Irish as senator and I am filled with great gratitude to you for the support that you have given me in my role.

I was the first Irish emigrant appointed to the Seanad to represent the Irish living overseas and I have tried my best to bring your voice to the corridors of power in Leinster House. I have worked to ensure that the issues Irish emigrants face upon returning home are mitigated, including access to driver's licenses, insurance and education.

I have continued to work closely with the Taoiseach and his team to ensure that the issue of the Irish undocumented living in the USA is kept front and centre on the agenda and I have worked hard to create the conditions that will allow a future flow of US visas for Irish citizens wishing to work in the USA.

The issue of immigration remains a hot button topic in the USA but we as a people understand only too well the consequences of anti-immigrant xenophobia. It is why we view the current immigration debate with a sense of deja-vu and see beyond the political punchlines to the real families affected by a broken immigration system. The faces may have changed but the stories have not.

At home we have weathered the storm of the recent financial crisis and are now the European headquarters for some of America's biggest companies, including Facebook, Google and Microsoft to name but a few. We have the lowest unemployment in 14 years, with US multinationals accounting for much of the growth. We have almost a quarter of a million people working in export-focused foreign multinationals - up 100,000 since the crash in 2009.

Notwithstanding all of the success, Ireland faces her own challenges today, and none more so than the implications of Brexit. The Taoiseach and Tánaiste with all party support have -to their credit- worked fastidiously to ensure that the border between the Republic of Ireland and Northern Ireland remain open. It is our duty to preserve the hard-fought for peace, while at the same time managing the economic impact of one of our largest trading partners exiting the EU.

In closing, I would like to thank the Ireland Network Chicago for its continued support of front line Irish service agencies and leave you with the heartfelt belief that Ireland and Irish America's best days are still ahead. I congratulate you on your great success this year and wish you many more.
