

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR LETTER



I am thrilled to write this as the inaugural Executive Director of Ireland Network Chicago!

INC began in 2003 as a vision realized by a small group of ex-pats, many of whom remain active in the organization today. The concept - to serve as a business and social network of Irish living and working in Chicago - was so successful that other cities began to adopt the idea. In 2010, the national umbrella organization Irish Network USA was established to integrate the various chapters that had popped up across the U.S.

In 2018, former INC Presidents and members came together to launch the Advisory Board, with the shared goal to ensure the sustained growth of INC. The group agreed that a paid position was necessary to take the organization to the next level and focused on establishing proper governance and planning to get there.

In 2021, the Irish Government's Department of Foreign Affairs agreed with our vision and, through its Emigrant Support Programme, funded a part-time Executive Director role to oversee the organization's professional development and strategic direction.

And here we are today! My goal is to implement best practices in terms of board governance, strategic communications and, most importantly, membership engagement. I'm happy to share that membership has already tripled in just 10 months, and our strategic plan and supporting initiatives will strive to maintain this incredible momentum.

None of this would be possible without the dedication of INC's leadership team, led by President Garrett Diamond, Treasurer Nora Walsh and Secretary Dede Simon, and the inimitable Executive Committee and Advisory Board, all of whom who lend their time and talents because they believe in the future of INC. I'd also like to thank the Consulate General of Ireland team for their confidence in our mission.

On a personal note, I'd like to extend a special note of gratitude to Cliff Carlson, our IN Spirit Award winner. Twenty years ago, Cliff graciously allowed me to write for the Irish American News, an occasional gig that continued throughout graduate school in Ireland and still to this day. Ten years ago, Cliff introduced me to then-Consul General Aidan Cronin and encouraged him to hire me as Public Affairs Officer. He did, and it was while working for the Irish Consulate that I first become involved with INC. Tonight, I have the honor of presenting Cliff with the IN Spirit Award, a special moment that demonstrates the gift of connecting the dots among the Irish in Chicago.

This is a big year for INC. We will embark on a renewed five-year strategic plan, one that aims to inform, entice, and engage our members, partners, and the wider Irish community. We will continue to deliver on our mission to strengthen a vibrant, diverse Irish community that is connected to Ireland and to each other. And this time next year, we will usher in Ireland Network Chicago's 20th anniversary – now that is something to look forward to!

ABOUT THE AWARD

Each year, Ireland Network Chicago honors an individual who has made significant and sustained contributions to the Chicago Irish community with the IN Spirit Award. This Award expresses our profound gratitude and appreciation for an individual's incredible service to the Irish community.

It is our great privilege to honor **CLIFF CARLSON** with the 2022 IN Spirit Award! Cliff exemplifies the mission of Ireland Network Chicago. From his stewardship at the *Irish American News*, iBAM! and the Irish American Heritage Center, Cliff serves as the ultimate connector and advocate, joining people and organizations together in thoughtful and selfless ways that reflects his passion and support for the Irish in Chicago and beyond.

While Cliff is usually the person writing about the news, we are thrilled that tonight, he IS the news. Congratulations, Cliff!



ABOUT CLIFF CARLSON

Cliff had a newspaper route at age 11 in Chicago, then worked as a short order cook at age 13, delivered groceries, stocked shelves and ran a cash register at 14. At age 16 he was paid full wage as a cashier.

He was hired full-time by Safeway Stores while still in high school, and went on to manage six different stores for the company in Arizona and California. When approached about being a district manager, he decided to step down and try being his own boss.

A typing class he took in high school led to him involvement in the publishing business, and in 1980 he helped create a food industry buyer's guide in California. He brought that concept to Chicago in 1983 and founded Food Industry News, a very successful trade publication which he sold to his partner in 1991.

He bought *Irish American News* that same year from the original publisher, Bob Burns. In 2007 Cliff expanded *Irish American News*, founding *IAN Ohio*, an Irish paper in Ohio now in its 15th year.

Cliff then formed a newspaper group called AIM American Irish Media, bringing the leaders of nine Irish American newspapers from around the country together to combine strengths and promote the advertising and editorial needs of customers beyond the borders of Chicago.

In 2009, Cliff, and his wife, Cathy, created iBAM! which fulfills the mission of the Irish American Heritage Center, and has developed into a respected cultural event honoring those of Irish Heritage around the world.
